Notice Inviting Manufacturers of Agriculture Machineries for Registration in DBT Portal

The Director of Agriculture, Govt. of Assam, hereby invites manufacturers of agriculture machineries/ implements/ equipment to register themselves in the DBT Portal, managed by Mechanization & Training Division of DAC & FW, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Government of India, at <https://agrimachinery.nic.in> immediately and take follow up action as per Initial Preparatory Steps (IPS) and SOPs uploaded in the Portal. For procurement of agriculture machineries/ implements/ equipment as per provision under different centrally sponsored and central sector schemes implemented in the state of Assam, shall be on-boarded in this DBT portal. For the current financial year 2021-22, CSS-“Sub-Mission on Agriculture Mechanization (SMAM)” has been on-boarded and would be implemented through the DBT Portal. Registration of manufactures along with their dealers, uploading of product details including valid test reports and dealer’s prices are mandatory for participation in the procurement process of agriculture machineries available as per provision under SMAM scheme for the state. In addition to the norms outlined in the Operational Guidelines of SMAM and other T&C uploaded in the DBT Portal, registered manufacturers shall comply following Terms and Conditions-

Terms & conditions:

1. Manufacturers and dealers credentials to be complied in all respect as per registration process in the DBT Portal.
2. Valid test reports issued from approved testing institute for particular machinery/ implements, which to be procured under the schematic provisions must be submitted as and when sought for verification.
3. Spares and service facility must be available with the dealers registered for a district. The Department of Agriculture reserves the right to physically verify availability of service facility and spares with the dealer in the districts.
4. Dealers’ price should be competitive and inclusive of all applicable tax/ GST, transportation cost, warranty and other costs up to dealers’ delivery outlet.
5. Comprehensive warranty for a period of minimum 1 year (12 months) is mandatory for all machineries procured through the DBT Portal.
6. The Department reserves the right to approve/disapprove any manufacturer/ dealer or their product and offered rate without assigning any reason thereof.
7. Manufacturers would complete the process of uploading as detailed above within 45 (Forty five) days from the date of publication of this notice.
