

Minutes of the meeting of Inter Departmental Working Group (IDWG) on PMKSY Scheme held in the office chamber of Additional Chief Secretary, Agriculture Department and APC Govt. of Assam on 11.01.2017 at 3.00 pm

The meeting was chaired by Shri K.K.Mittal IAS, Additional Chief Secretary Agriculture Department and APC, Govt. of Assam with participation of other Stake holding Departments like Agriculture, Irrigation, Soil Conservation, Agriculture Extension (ATMA) and other allied Departments.

At the outset the Chairman welcomed all the members present in the meeting and the minutes of the last IDWG meeting held on 01/09/2016 was reviewed. The Chairman pointed out the issue raised by Soil Conservation Department regarding their Watershed Development Scheme incorporated in PMKSY, which was to be approved by Governing Body as per their procedure and now same is to be approved by SLSC also. While replying to the question of Chairman the Jt. Director of Soil Conservation Department clarified that their AAP has already been approved by the Governing Body. The Chairman said that the IDWG will also approve the same today for final approval of SLSC. Another issue was regarding formation of a society for implementation of PMKSY Scheme has been processed by the Department. The Chairman clarified that the proposal is under process and it is now at AR & Training Department for consideration/approval.

The General Manager, NABCONS gave a brief deliberation on preparation of DIP and SIP and various activities incorporated in DIP/SIP as per GOI Guideline. He highlighted the different aspects of the SIP showing District wise and Department wise allocation and expected outcome. He informed the House that the SIP prepared against PMKSY is not only the compilation of the DIPs of 27 Districts of Assam, it is the aggregation of various works proposed by stake holder Departments for achieving assured irrigation in Agril. field of State for growth of Agril. production and productivity. He focused on the salient features of SIP as being the total project cost of Rs. 47,700.00 Crores for five year plan. Department wise plan share is Irrigation 69.03 %, Agriculture 21.55%, Soil Conservation 7.35%, DRDA 1.42% and Water Resources Department is 0.65%.

Thereafter each stake holding Department made their Departmental presentation showing activities to be undertaken by them viz: AAP 2016-17 with detail collaboration on physical & financial target.

After due deliberation the Committee under the Chairmanship of the Additional Chief Secretary & APC approved the AAP, SIP and DIP with the recommendation that it may be placed before the SLSC for due approval. The Department wise presentation of AAP is enclosed as under:-


