

Brief Report
on Centrally sponsored Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) Scheme

Background :- The Cabinet Committee of Economic Affairs chaired by Hon'ble Prime Minister had accorded approval of PMKSY in its meeting held on 1st July/2015. PMKSY has been conceived as an amalgamation of ongoing schemes viz Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP) of Ministry of Water Resource , Integrated Watershed Management Project (IWMP) of Department of Land Resource and on Farm Water Management (OFWM) of Deptt. of Agriculture & Co-operation.

Objective:- The basic objective of PMKSY Scheme is to achieve convergence of investments in irrigation at field level, expand cultivable area under assured irrigation, improve on-farm Water use efficiency to reduce wastage of water, enhance the adoption of precision-irrigation and other Water saving technologies, enhance recharge of aquifers and introduce sustainable water conservation practices and attract greater private investments in precision irrigation system.

Component of Works :-

- a. Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP)
- b. Har Khet ko Pani
- c. Per Drop More Crop
- d. Watershed Development

Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) is a centrally sponsored Scheme with 90% Central assistance and 10% State share, started in the state of Assam from mid of Financial year, 2015-16. Status of fund release till now is shown as below-

Progress of the Scheme till now-

- NABCONS (Subsidiary of NABARD) is entrusted to assist/facilitate the District Level Implementation Committee (DLIC) for preparation of District Irrigation Plan (DIP) for 5 Years and to compile all approved DIPs of State into a comprehensive SIP for 5 years (2016-17 to 2020-21) as per Govt. of India Guidelines after due approval of **Chief Secretary, Assam.**
- Accordingly, all twenty Seven (27) Nos. of District irrigation Plan (DIP) have been finalized and approved by DLIC (District level Implementation Committee). All approved DIP's are also uploaded in the GOI provided PMKSY website.(pmksy.gov.in)
- State Irrigation Plan (SIP) has been approved in the SLSC meeting held on 01/02/2017 along with the all Annual Action Plan submitted by all Line Departments for the year 2016-17. SIP has also been uploaded in the GOI website of PMKSY.
- As per State Budget provision on PMKSY Scheme for the year 2017-18 under Head of Account "Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana(PMKSY)-Per Drop More Crop (Micro Irrigation)" is shown as under
